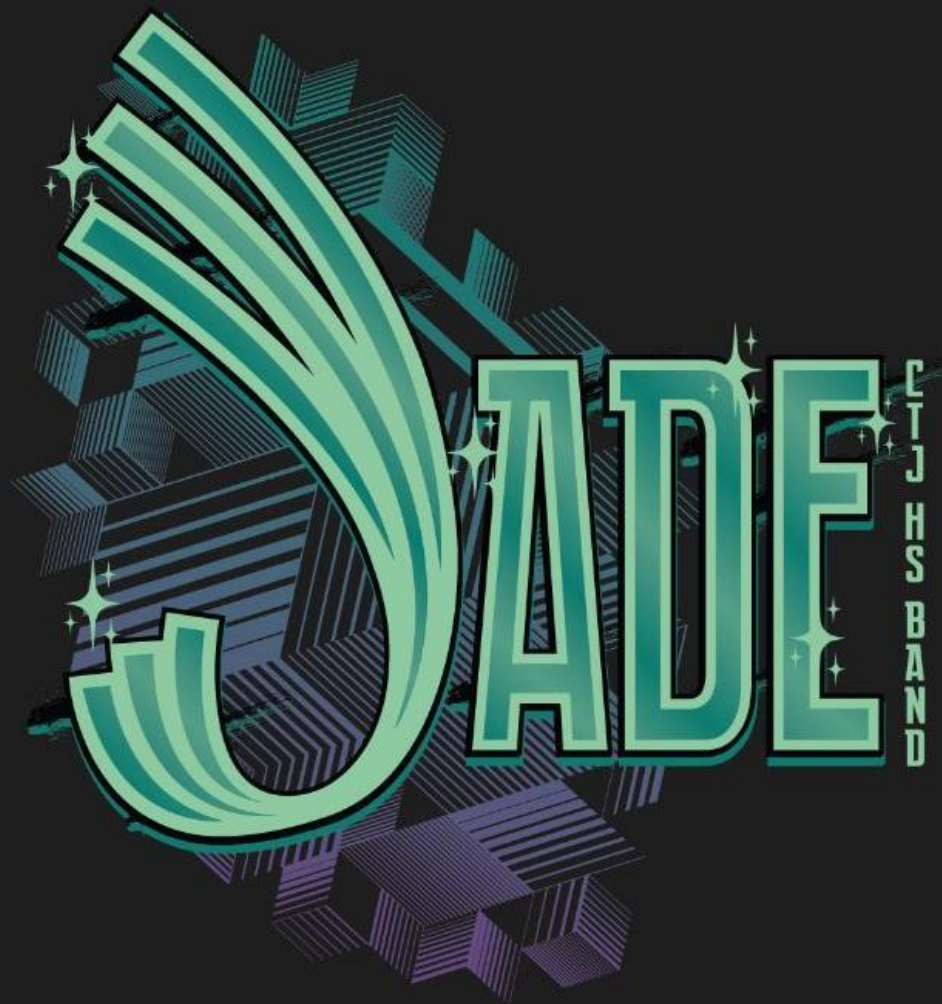



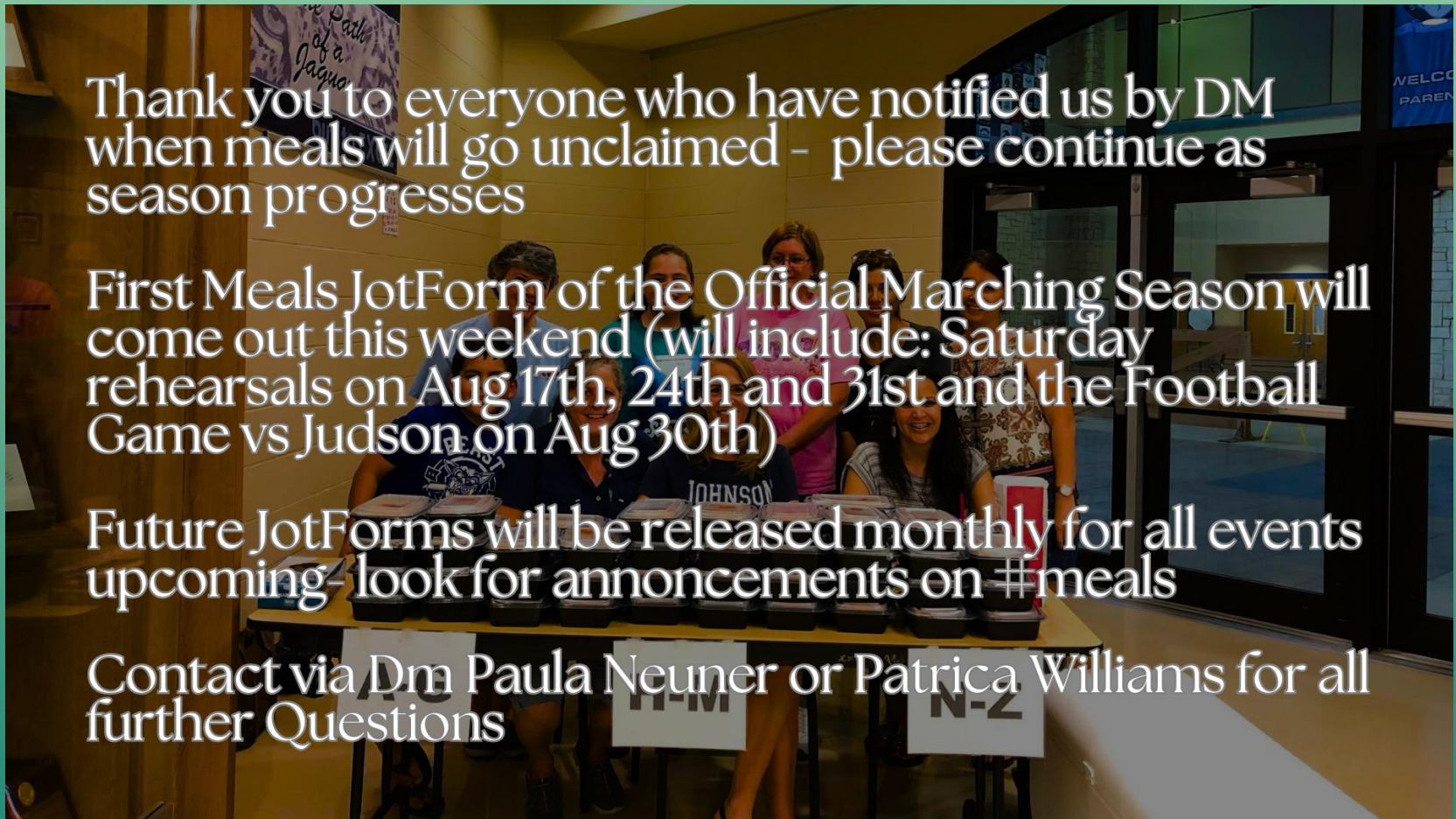
Meals

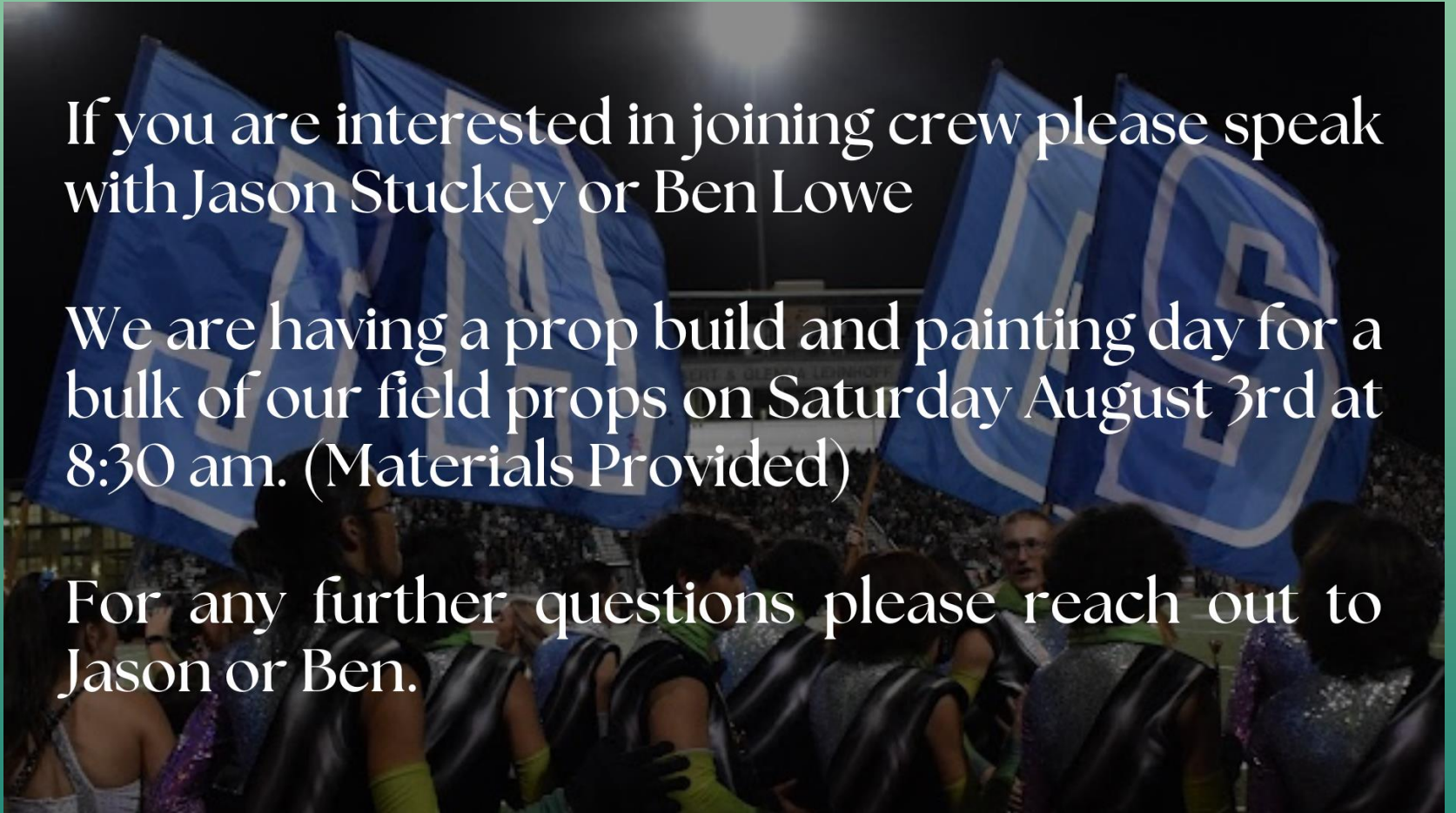


Crew
